Caring for the community through emergency relief efforts

The Salvation Army Malaysia has been assisting survivors of various tragedies via its emergency relief efforts.

In **January**, our Kuching team attended to the needs of 18 families in town who lost their homes to a fire.

The month of February saw our team from the Regional Headquarters helping 222 households in Bukit Besi, Terengganu to recover from a devastating flood, our Melaka team providing help to households who were made homeless due to a fire, our Kuching team lending a helping hand to flood survivors in Bau and Kuching, and our Ipoh team visiting a family who lost their home to a fire.

March rolled in and our Kota Kinabalu team assisted a total of 16 families whose homes were lost to a fire. Meanwhile, our Kuching team assisted 6 people who lost their workers' hostel to a fire in Kuching.

survivors were given essentials catered to their circumstances (food, cleaning aids, clothing, furniture, etc).

Our teams will also ensure they get back on their feet and receive proper and adequate assistance.
