So far we have raised more than RM 550,00.00, and the funds collected in each of the locations will be kept and used within the locality.





The Salvation Army has a long legacy of lending assistance when disaster strikes.

Between July to September, our Kuching Corps and Community Services team attended to three villages in Sarawak that were lost to fires. The team provided food parcels and a listening ear.

In July, floods hit several parts of Kota Kinabalu and our team distributed RM100 worth of supermarket vouchers to 229 affected households.

Our Bintulu team sprung into action when the Bintulu Methodist Church asked if we could help donate mineral water and biscuits to a village on the outskirts, to assist 32 families (325 people) who lost their homes to a fire during the Malaysia Day weekend.
